Impressive Size, Exceptional Taste

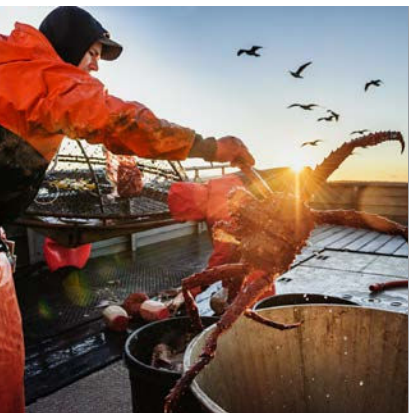

Harvested from the Icy Bering Sea

Keyport's Alaska Red King crab is harvested from the cold, pristine, and nutrient rich waters of Bristol Bay. They prefer the sandy, muddy ocean floor along the continental shelf where they are typically found in shallow coastal waters in depths of less than 200 feet. Their extremely cold habitat slows their growth, allowing for a long lifespan and the development of larger and meatier legs.

Stewardship and Sustainability

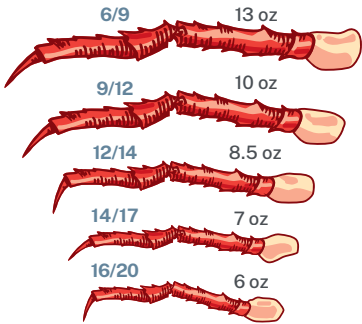
The remarkable size and taste of Red King crab make it a very valuable and sought-after species. Great demand for Red King crab, however, has also led to great protections. Each year, fisherman, processors, scientists, coastal communities, and state agencies work together to sustainably manage the stocks for future generations. Collaboratively, harvest limits are set and shares are allocated through programs that address both economic and environmental issues. This series of robust programs also includes a community quota to protect the interests of coastal communities and real-time monitoring of the harvest.



Harvested from the icy currents of the Bering Sea, Alaska Red King crab is the largest of all King crab species and can measure up to five feet across and weigh in at over 20 pounds.

Red King Crab Leg Sizing

King crab legs are sized according to the number of crab legs in a ten-pound package. Legs labeled '6/9', for example, are large and it only takes 6 to 9 legs to make up a 10 lb box. A 20 lb box of '6/9' legs would have 12 to 18 legs and a 30 lb box would contain 18 to 27 legs.

Our Red King crab leg sizes include (from largest to smallest): 4/7, 6/9, 9/12, 12/14, 14/17, 16/20



Purchasing Wholesale Red King Crab

King crab have six legs and two claws. Each wholesale box of King crab includes this natural proportion of legs to claws. So, if you have 12 legs in a box, you can expect to find 4 claws as well.
